Planning your visit:

Ways to travel to Clifton Down



- If you travel by car, you can access the centre car park from Alma Road. Use the postcode **BS8 2NN** to find it
- The car park has 7 levels with 360 spaces, including disabled and parent/child bays. It holds the Park Mark Safer Parking Award
- It is open from 7.00am to 10.30pm.
- Sainsbury's customers get up to 2 hours free if they spend £20 or more in-store, thereafter a reduced fee will apply.



- Clifton Down Station is adjacent to the shopping centre.
- There are regular trains from Bristol Temple Meads to Clifton Down Station.

- First UK Bus have lots of buses operating in the Bristol area.
- Check www.firstgroup.com/bristol-bath-and-west or timetables
- The nearest bus stop is Clifton Down Station, adjacent to the centre.



- The taxi rank is outside the front of the shopping centre, **next to the bus stop**.



- If you travel on bicycle, we have cycle parking stands around the shopping centre, adjacent to the Clifton Down Train Station entrance, Starbucks and the EE store on **Whiteladies Road**.
- We also provide a free air pump for cyclists.


